Sun protection policy

Our pre-school takes very seriously the health and safety of the children in its care. We acknowledge the advice given by Cancer Research UK and in particular its Sun Smart campaign.

Aim

To protect the children when playing out in the sun. To educate the children on how to be safe in the sun.

Method

We will:

- Ensure that all children are adequately clothed in appropriate sun wear.
- Ensure that all children have had sunscreen applied before playing outside.
- Where children are not adequately protected we will take steps to adapt our activities in order to protect them.
- We will keep a supply of sunscreen on the premises, to be used in an emergency when parents have forgotten to apply it before they come to the pre-school.
- Provide a shaded area to protect the children whilst they play.
- Ensure that the children can access the indoor play area at all times so that they can choose to continue their play indoors.
- Ensure that there is an adequate supply of fresh drinking water available and that the children know how to access it.
- Ensure that safe sun behaviour is modelled by the staff of the pre-school, providing a positive role model to all the children.
